Peer Volunteer/Peer Counselor Position Description

Position Title: Peer Volunteer/Peer Counselor

Supervisor: Youth Program Assistant/Volunteer Coordinator/Youth & Family Specialists

Objective: To provide an opportunity for youth to acquire human service-related skills while

simultaneously developing leadership qualities through client contact, crisis counseling,

group facilitation, and community outreach.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Interact with teen shelter residents and other program participants as a positive peer figure:
 - a. Promote healthy relationships among residents.
 - b. Plan fun and educational group activities for residents
 - c. Assist residents with chores, meal preparation, and homework.
- 2. Assist staff with shelter duties:
 - a. Assist with shelter operations and community outreach about shelter services.
 - b. Answer calls on the crisis lines and make referrals to appropriate staff member.
 - c. Participate in group activities and monitor residents as needed.
- 3. Assist in the development of the peer volunteer program, including recruitment of peer participants, planning of the training, and overall implementation of the program in the shelter.
- 4. Act as a bridge between teens and staff and between agency programs and the community.
- 5. Advocate on behalf of teens within the program.
- 6. Attend all shifts, and required meetings and trainings.
- Follow all agency policies, shelter and group rules, including respecting the confidentiality of program participants and co-workers.

Desired Qualities:

- Must be a high school student, 14-17 years of age.
- Open-minded about different cultures, beliefs, and identities.
- Calm in challenging situations.
- Good listener.
- Ability to work cooperatively with other staff, accept supervision, and attend required trainings.
- Commitment to working with teen shelter residents and volunteers, in addition to other staff.
